ROLL-ON PAINTING has techniques to suit your schedule

"One technique is vapour barrier sheeting," he says. "If we're in the middle of a large office and doing one corner, we'll drop plastic sheeting from ceiling to floor and build a temporary wall. We can install temporary ductwork and an exhaust system to draw the sanding dust and the smell of paint out of the building and away from where people are working."

It's not always easy letting someone into your workspace overnight when no one else is around,

and that's why Chad says finding a reputable company is essential for your peace of mind.

"That level of trust doesn't come right away," he says. "I've been doing this for 20 years and I've earned a reputation. We also have extensive liability insurance, and all of our workers are bondable."

With locations in Barrie and Port Sydney, Roll-On has a coverage area from North Bay to Bradford along Highway 11. They recently hired a crew of painters from Collingwood and are setting up a location there as well.
